

IDEAL ROUTES ON KILIMANJARO

**MARANGU ROUTE** 

Among the numerous Kilimanjaro Routes, Marangu Route is the only one to offer sleeping huts. This route is also known as the Coca-Cola route. On this route the huts sell bottled cola, giving it the nickname.

> **CIRCUIT ROUTE** The Northern Circuit Route is a rather newer route and starts along the Lemosho route. It crosses the Shira route and circles around the slopes in the North.



KILIMANJARO HEIGHT It is the highest mountain in Africa and the highest single free-standing mountain in the world: 5,895 metres (19,341 ft) above sea level and about 4,900 metres (16,100 ft) above its plateau




