

2 DAYS *Tanzania Camping Safari*

Game viewing along the Tarangire River and inside the Ngorongoro Crater make this 2-day camping safari an intense experience of animals and spectacular landscapes.



Day 1

Kilimanjaro International Airport to Moshi

A staff member of Jerry Tanzania Tours will pick you up from the Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO). From here you will be driven to Hotel in Moshi and briefed on your upcoming safari. Enjoy a restful night before beginning your safari tomorrow.

Day 2

Moshi – Tarangire National Park – Karatu

In the morning at around 6:00 a.m. your safari guide will arrive at the hotel and inform the receptionist that he is waiting for you. After meeting up with your guide you will start your approximate four-hour journey to Tarangire National Park. The park, with its savannah, seasonal swamps and baobab trees, is well known for its large number of elephant herds. During the dry seasons the Tarangire river, being one of the main sources of water in the area, attract various animals, such as bushbucks, hartebeests and giraffes from not only the park itself but the neighboring Lake Manyara National Park. After an extensive game drive, enjoyed from the open roof of the vehicle, you will leave the park and travel to a nearby campsite, where you will overnight.

Day 3

Karatu – Ngorongoro Crater – Moshi

An early start is on the agenda today as you make your way to Ngorongoro Crater, one of the most stunning places on Earth. Once you have reached the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, you will descend down an adventurous path into the 600 m caldera. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1979, this massive collapsed volcano is home to over 25,000 mammals such as spotted hyenas and the “Big Five” – elephant, rhino, buffalo, leopard and lion. After the game drive, there will be time for a picnic lunch near the beautiful Hippo Lake. After lunch, you will have time for a short game drive and then ascend the crater and exit Ngorongoro Conservation Area towards Moshi
